Report a Violation

The CCO respects your confidentiality but cannot accept anonymous complaints.

All complaints received by the Office are subject to public records law. Note: Florida has a very broad public records law. To report a violation, please call or email with the following information:

- Type of violation.
- Location with address if possible.
- Your name and address (Per FSS, unless there is imminent danger to the public or a public health, safety, or welfare concern, **anonymous complaints cannot be investigated.**)
- Any additional information.
- If you wish to be contacted by CCO pertaining to your report, please provide your email or phone number.



Dear Belle Isle Resident,

Did you know that operating a business within the City of Belle Isle requires a Local Business Tax Receipt (BTR)? Whether you are running a storefront, a commercial enterprise, or a home-based business within city limits, you must secure a BTR BEFORE opening. All licenses must be renewed by the September 30th deadline each year to avoid a 25% late penalty.

To comply, download the official [Belle Isle Business Tax Receipt Application](http://www.belleislefl.gov) from www.belleislefl.gov and submit your completed form via email to admin@belleislefl.gov. For questions or renewals, you can visit City Hall at 1600 Nela Avenue, call the administration line at 407-851-7730, or contact the City Clerk directly at yquiceno@belleislefl.gov.

Before applying for a Business Tax Receipt, you must first confirm if your business is located within the City of Belle Isle: <https://ocpaweb.ocpafl.org/parcelsearch>

Don't forget that your approved Belle Isle receipt must be secured before you apply for your [Orange County Business Tax Receipt](https://www.octaxcol.com/taxes/business-taxes/obtain-new-business-tax-receipt/)-
