WHEREAS, the City of Belle Isle of Orange County, Florida, adopted a tentative millage rate on September 16, 2025, following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025, and ending on September 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2025, the City of Belle Isle held a final public hearing on the millage rate for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025, and ending on September 30, 2026, as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Orange County has been certified by the Orange County

Property Appraiser to the City of Belle Isle as \$1,170,889,682; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Belle Isle has determined that the millage rate of 4.7845 mills is necessary to provide the revenue to fund the budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025, and ending on September 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Belle Isle, Florida, of Orange County, Florida, that:

SECTION 1. The City Council adopts the final millage rate of 4.7845 mills for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2025, and ending on



September 30, 2026. 1 2 SECTION 2. The final millage rate of 4.7845 mills is greater than the rolled-back rate of 4.1618 mills by 14.96%. 3 SECTION 3.
