Come meet the City's team and learn about two important planning initiatives happening in Belle Isle:

The **Belle Isle Vision Zero Action Plan** is part of a regional effort led by MetroPlan Orlando to reduce traffic fatalities and severe injuries, creating safer roads for both the 2.2 million residents and 75 million tourists who visit Central Florida annually. Coordinated Vision Zero Action Plans will be created for cities and counties throughout the region made possible by a \$3.8 million federal Safe Streets for All (SS4A) grant. Help us identify the key traffic safety concern for Belle Isle residents.

The **2024 Comprehensive Plan update** is the City's first major update to its Comprehensive Plan in over 10 years. This effort will set forth policies related to growth, public infrastructure, the environment, transportation, and other important topics for the City over the next 20+ years. An important part of this project is to acquire public comment so that it is truly a resident driven document. Please join us and provide your comments and feedback so this may be the best Comprehensive Plan possible to help guide the City of Belle Isle through the next generation.

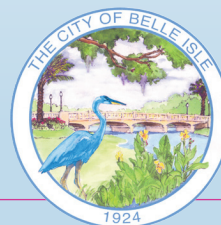
